


How do I login to the UNC Wireless Network.

The University of Northern Colorado has three wireless networks available to its community members, UNC-STUDENT, UNC-ADMIN, & UNC-GUEST. Please see descriptions below for further information regarding these wireless networks.

UNC-STUDENT – This network is specifically provided for the use of students enrolled at UNC. Once connected to this wireless network, authentication utilizing your Personal Digital Identity (PDID) is required via a web browser for student verification. This is the same PDID/login that is used to access Ursa, Blackboard or a computer lab workstation.

UNC-ADMIN – This network is specifically provided for the use of faculty, staff, and administrative personnel at UNC. Once connected to this wireless network, authentication utilizing your Personal Digital Identity (PDID) is required via a web browser for employment verification. This is the same PDID/login that is used to log access Ursa, Blackboard or an office workstation.

UNC-GUEST – This network is specifically provided for the use of visitors to UNC. Once connected to this wireless network, authentication utilizing a guest account is required (UNC PDID's are **not** valid for authentication). Obtaining a guest account is as easy as finding a UNC student, faculty, staff, or administrator to “sponsor” or create a guest account. Any individual with a UNC PDID can log onto <https://unc-guest.unco.edu> and create an account that will be based off of the guest's email address. This process will email the account information to the guest. If the guest does not have a sponsor they can call the Technical Support Center at 970-351-4357 to have an account created.

In order to access the guest network, you must have received a guest username and password. This can be obtained in two ways:

1. If you have a UNC contact with a valid UNC PDID (ex: joe.smith or smit1234) they can sponsor you as a guest and create a guest account using this link <https://unc-guest.unco.edu>. If you do not have a UNC contact please proceed with using option 2.

2. Contact the Technical Support Center (970) 351-4357 and a representative will assist you in creating a guest account.

Once you have received your guest account, you will need to return to this page and login below using your newly created account.
